PENNSYLVANIA NOTICE Insurance Consultation Services Exemption Act

The Conemaugh Valley Mutual Insurance Company may provide such services as consultations, inspections, and surveys of your property and operations in accordance with the provisions of its policies with the goal of reducing the likelihood of injury, death or loss.

This Notice is provided to you pursuant to the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania known as the "Insurance Consultation Act", which generally provides that the Conemaugh Valley Mutual Insurance Company, its agents, employees, or service contractors are not liable for damages from injury, death or loss occurring as a result of any act or omission by any person in the furnishing or the failure to furnish such services.

The Act does not apply:

- If the injury, death or loss occurred during the actual performance of the consultation services and was caused by our negligence or the negligence of our agents, employees or service contractors.
- 2. To consultation services performed under a written service contract not related to an insurance policy; or
- If an act, or omission by the Conemaugh Valley Mutual Insurance Company, its agents, employees or service contractors is determined by law to constitute a crime, actual malice or gross negligence.

MUTUAL POLICY CONDITIONS

This policy is issued by a Mutual Company organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. All persons insuring and continuing insured by this Company shall be members thereof during the period they shall remain so insured.

This policy is non-assessable, and the named insured shall not be liable for any additional contingent premium or any other contingent liability of this policy.

The Annual Meeting of the members will be held on the second Saturday of January of each year at 1:00 PM prevailing time or at such other place and time on or before May 1st of each year as the Board of Directors shall determine for the purpose of electing Directors of the Company and conducting such other business pertinent to the welfare of the Company as the Directors and officers may deem necessary.
